



St. Martin de Porres Outreach

2017 Summary

- **331,824 pounds of food** given to the less fortunate and homeless population.
- **9,347** individuals from 2,629 Families received food at the pantry which operates every Monday. In addition, food was provided to 3 other remote operations.
- **27,772** meals served in a welcoming and supportive environment, in the Café which serves five nights a week (22,989 served on site and an additional 4,783 meals delivered to the homeless)
- **476** Children received sneakers and grade-appropriate stuffed backpacks.
- **812** Children received Christmas gifts with a visit from Santa.
- **325** Children attended an Easter Egg Hunt, which also provided bags of food in time for Easter.
- Health screenings and appropriate treatments were provided throughout the year.
- We have been successful at getting individuals to obtain appropriate insurance coverage, directed into treatment as appropriate and moved into housing wherever possible.
- **18** Children received after school help Monday through Thursday while school is in session.
- **12** individuals receive English as a Second Language classes once a week.
- We are an approved location for individuals who are required by the courts to do service hours. They have been extremely valuable in maintaining the building and managing the garden.
